You can see from this excerpt that MFA is required for all users regardless of function to access the CJI system. Also, the Audit/Sanction Date is shown to be 10/1/2024.

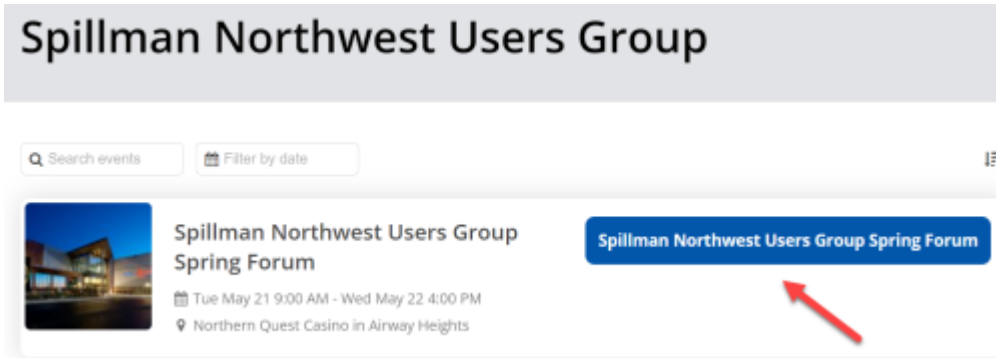

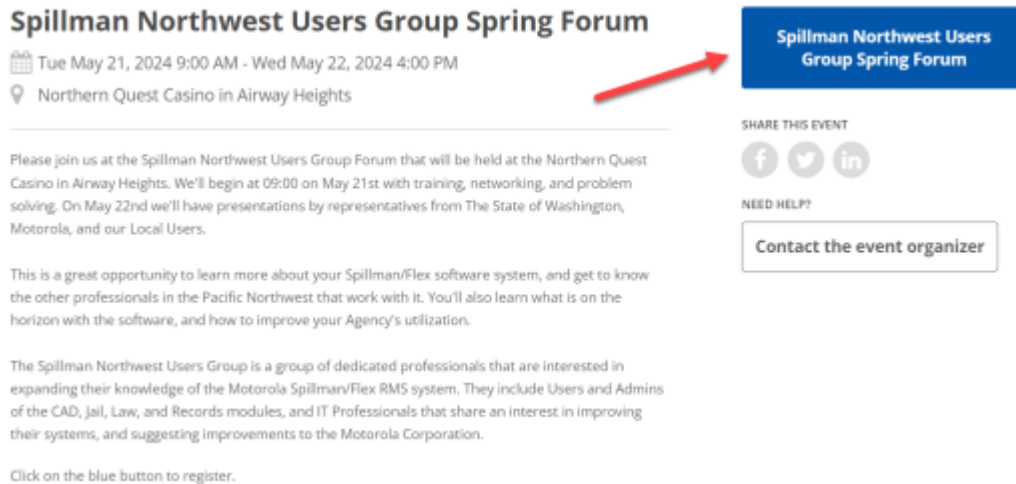

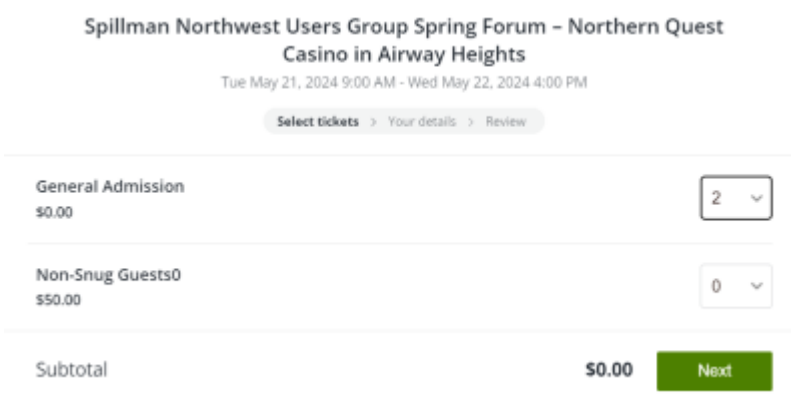
